

School District MAEP Funding for FY2022

The columns below show the amount of state Mississippi Adequate Education Program (MAEP) funding allocated to school districts for the 2021-2022 school year compared to the amount districts would have received if fully funded according to state law. The last two columns in red show each district's shortfall (the amount below what is required by state law) for FY2022 and cumulatively since FY2008, the last time the MAEP was fully funded. Also shown is each district's funding increase/decrease from FY2021 to FY2022.
