

School District Funding for 2023-2024

The columns below show the amount of state funding allocated to school districts for the 2023-2024 school year compared to the amount districts would have received if fully funded according to state law. The last two columns in red show each district's shortfall (the amount below what is required by state law) for FY2024 and cumulatively since FY2008, the last time

the MAEP was fully funded. Also shown is each district's funding increase/decrease from FY2023 to FY2024. *In the 2023 Legislative Session, funds were allocated separately for MAEP, the 2022 teacher pay raise, and an additional \$100-million that is to be used by districts in the same way MAEP funds are used. We have combined all of those allocations in the FY2024 Total Allocation column, and we have counted the extra \$100-million toward "full funding" of public schools.
